




Easy Read Privacy Notice

Your Information:



Personal data is information about someone.





The government has made a law to keep safe all information about you.







This means that staff who have information about you will have to keep this information private and safe at all times.











This information might include your:

- name
- date of birth
- address
- Phone number
- weight
- height













Other information may include:

- health problems and treatments you receive
- Information about you and your family.
 and who you live with
- what is important to you
- work you have done
- Finance

Why we collect information about you:







We need to keep information about the treatment you have had and who has helped you. To ensure you get the best treatment now and in the future.







This information can be seen by other medical staff in the hospital who may also be giving you some treatment or help.







This information about you helps all staff in the hospital or in the community providing a service to you to give you the best possible care.

This Law is called the Data Protection Act 2018










What does this law say?




Who do we share information about you with?

The hospital may share information about you with other services including:

- Doctors
- Other hospitals
- Ambulance services
- Social workers
- Teachers
- Local councils
- Police constables
- Voluntary services
- Care homes



















Is there a problem?
