Leaving a gift in your will

Leaving us a gift in your will makes a lasting difference.

Charitable legacies are paid before tax is deducted, reducing the amount of tax that has to be paid when your estate is being distributed. A gift in your will can take the form of:

- a residuary gift – this is the remainder of your estate once your family have been provided for;
- a pecuniary gift – this is a specific sum of money pledged to charity;
- a specific gift – this can be property, stocks and shares or other valuables such as a piece of jewellery.
